

Four People in Household Example:

Let's say there are 4 people in your household. Currently there are 65 gallons daily allocated per person. Here's the math:

$$4 \times 65 = 260 \text{ Gallons of Water Per Day for the Household}$$

In this example, the daily amount (260 gallons) is multiplied by 30 to determine the household's monthly indoor allocation of water. Here's the math:

$$30 \text{ days in month} \times 260 \text{ allocated indoor gallons of water} = 7,800 \text{ gallons per month}$$

Water Efficiency Rate (1,000-8,000 gallons) = \$3.55/1,000 gallons
(Family of four is up to 7,800 gallons per month for indoor use)

- 3.55 x 1 = \$3.55
- 3.55 x 2 = \$7.10
- 3.55 x 3 = \$10.65
- 3.55 x 4 = \$14.20
- 3.55 x 5 = \$17.75
- 3.55 x 6 = \$21.30
- 3.55 x 7 = \$24.85
- 3.55 x 8 = \$28.40

Excessive Rate Charge (9,000-12,000 gallons) = \$7.10/1,000 gallons
(up to 150% above allocation)

- 7.10 x 1 = \$7.10 (1,000 gallons over 8,000 - 9,000)
- 7.10 x 2 = \$14.20 (2,000 gallons over 8,000 - 10,000)
- 7.10 x 3 = \$21.30 (3,000 gallons over 8,000 - 11,000)
- 7.10 x 4 = \$28.40 (4,000 gallons over 8,000 - 12,000)

Abusive Rate Charge (13,000+ gallons) = \$10.66/1,000 gallons

- 10.66 x 1 = \$10.66 (1,000 gallons over 12,000 - 13,000)
- 10.66 x 2 = \$21.32 (2,000 gallons over 12,000 - 14,000)
- 10.66 x 3 = \$31.98 (3,000 gallons over 12,000 - 15,000)
